**RECOGNITION ON A JOB WELL
DONE**

Tourism District Unit, Bravo 1 Patrol & ACPD SWAT (Commanded by Lt. Moynihan & Lt. Arra)

On March 5, 2026, Bravo 1 TDU Officers, along with CRDA overtime officers and Bravo 1 Patrol Officers, conducted a proactive operation targeting Atlantic Avenue and Pacific Avenue. During the operation, officers established probable cause that individuals were distributing CDS from the Martinique Motel on Pacific Avenue.

Based on their information, Sgt. Hambrecht applied for and was granted a search warrant for the specific room. SWAT executed a knock-and-announce warrant and located five (5) individuals inside the room.

A total of eight (8) individuals were arrested for CDS and related offenses. Three Drug Offender Restraining Orders (DOROs) were submitted. Additionally, four motor vehicle summonses were issued to an individual during an unrelated motor vehicle stop. In total, 35 charges and 5 of the individuals were placed on a warrant and sent to Atlantic County Justice facility

All should be commended for excellent collaboration and team work!

Alpha CIS (Commanded by Lt. Michael Garofalo)

On March 12, 2026, patrol officers responded to the High Gate for a male bleeding. A victim was located suffering from stab wounds and transported to the medical center. CIS personnel initiated an investigation.

During the investigation, they determined the 911 caller entered the apartment and observed the victim being washed off by who would later learn to be the suspect. Throughout the day, detectives collected surveillance video from the hallway, trash chute, and neighboring apartments. They also conducted multiple interviews. The detectives collected enough evidence for criminal charges despite not interviewing the victim due to being sedated after immediate surgery.

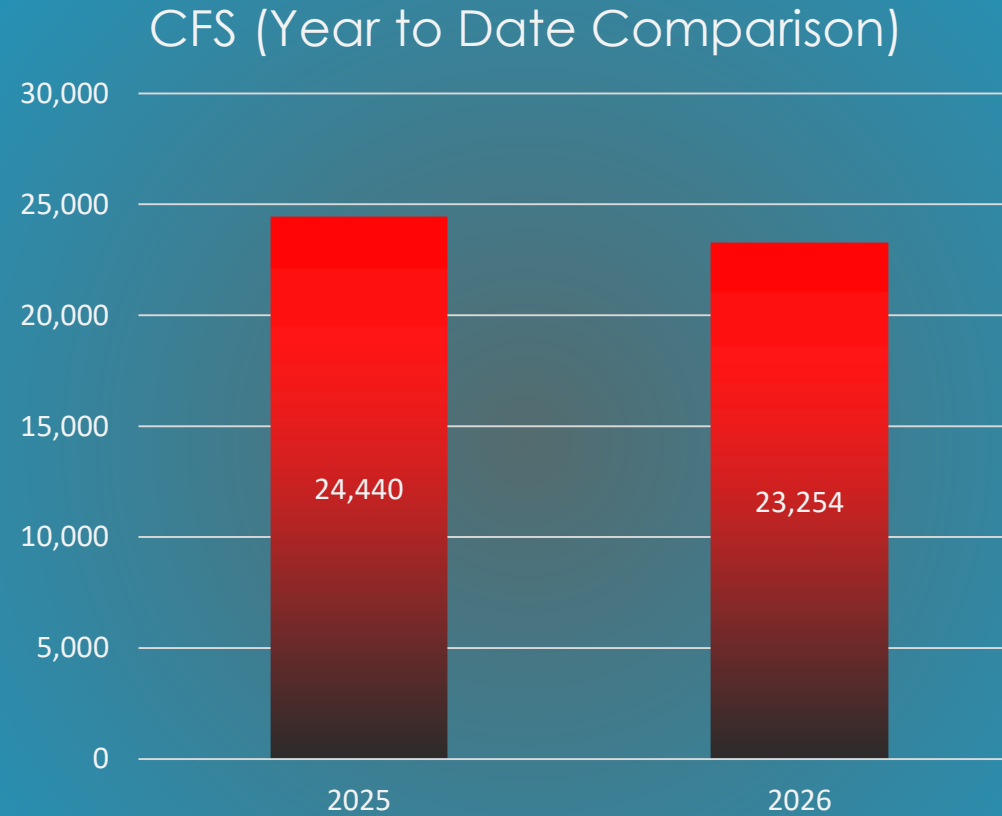
Ultimately, the victim was interviewed confirming the detective's work and the suspect, who was a family member, was additionally charged with attempted murder.

As of March 30, 2026

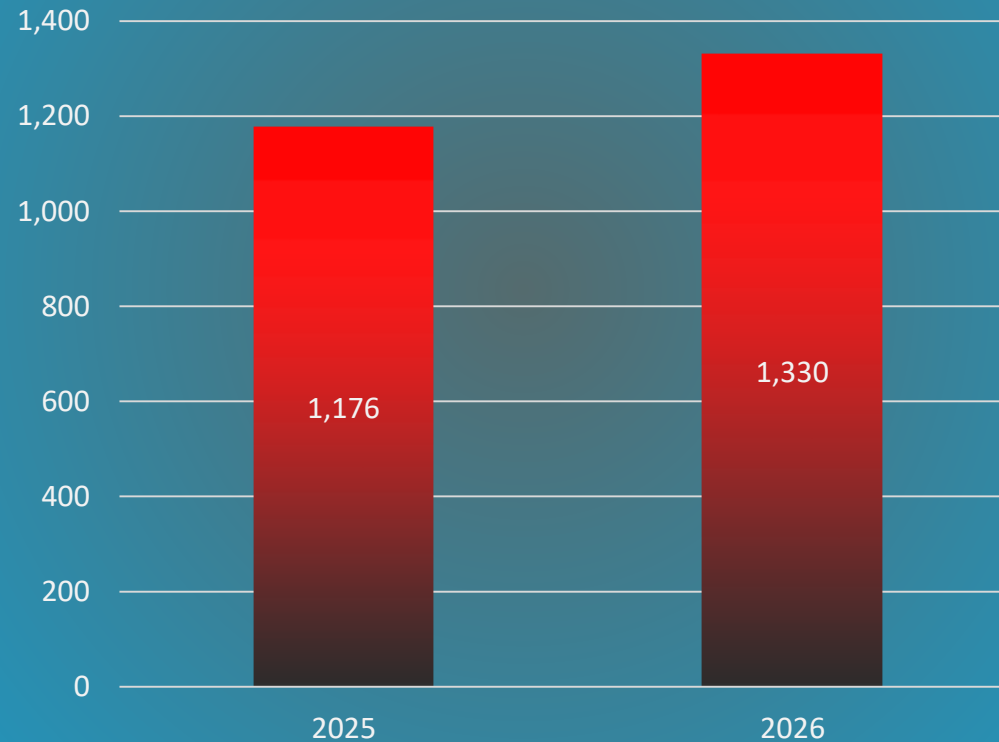


Calls for Service are down

- **96.04%** of cases were responded to within 24 hours

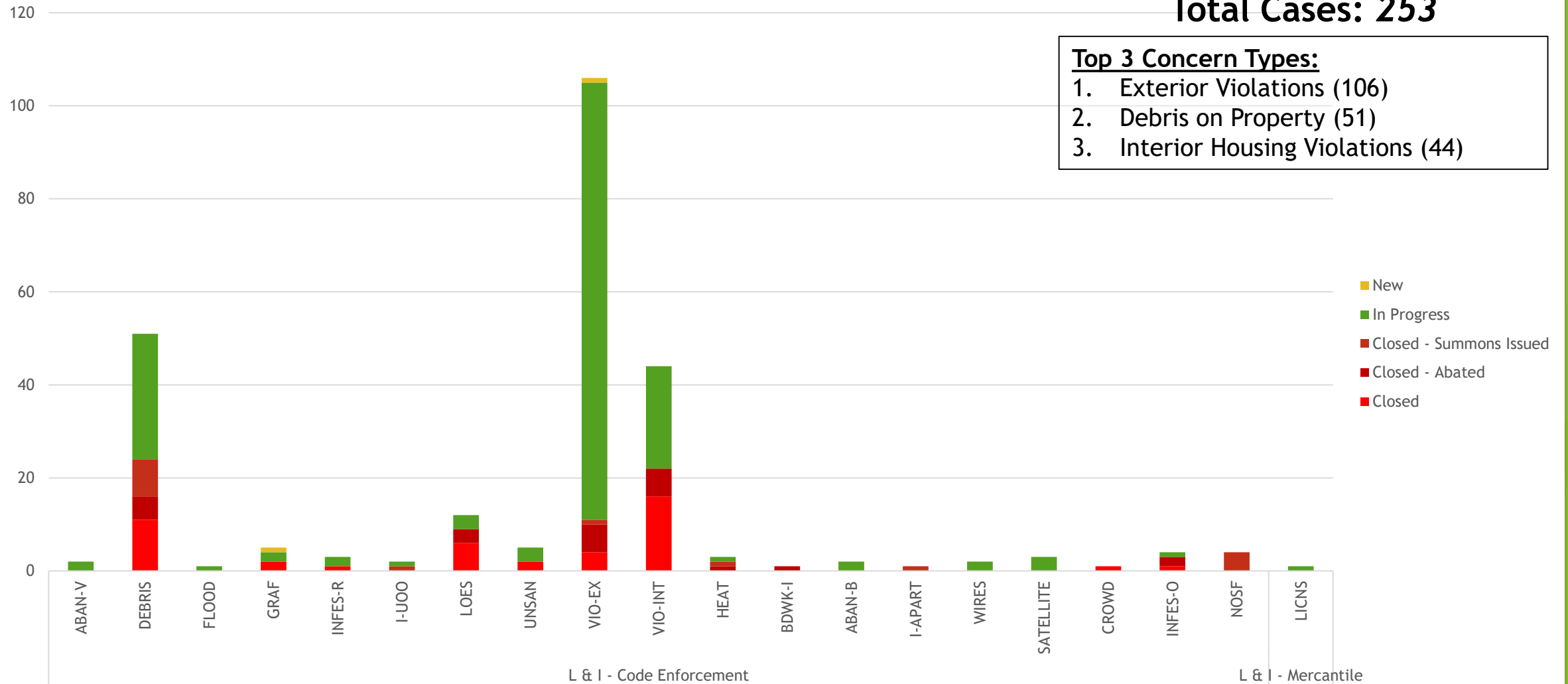
An additional **104** cases from prior periods were also closed for a total of **203** cases closed during this period

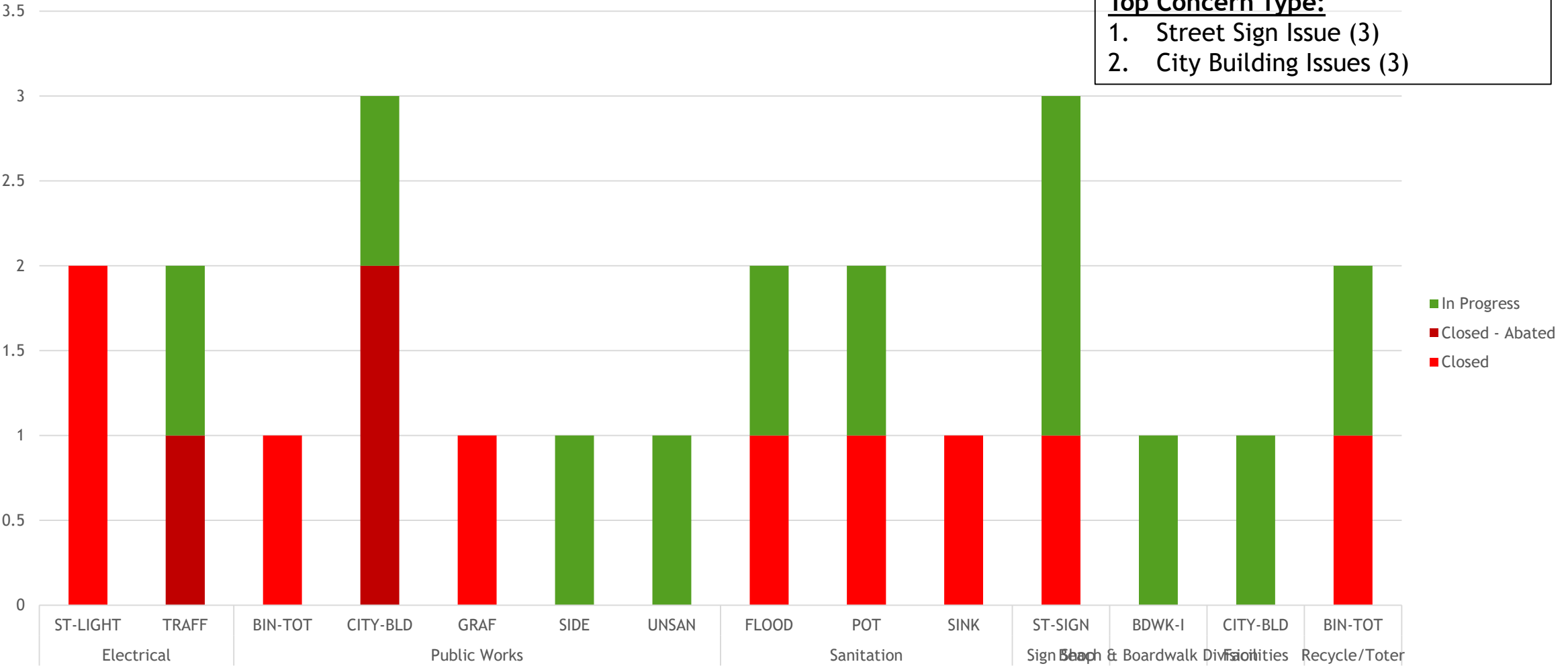

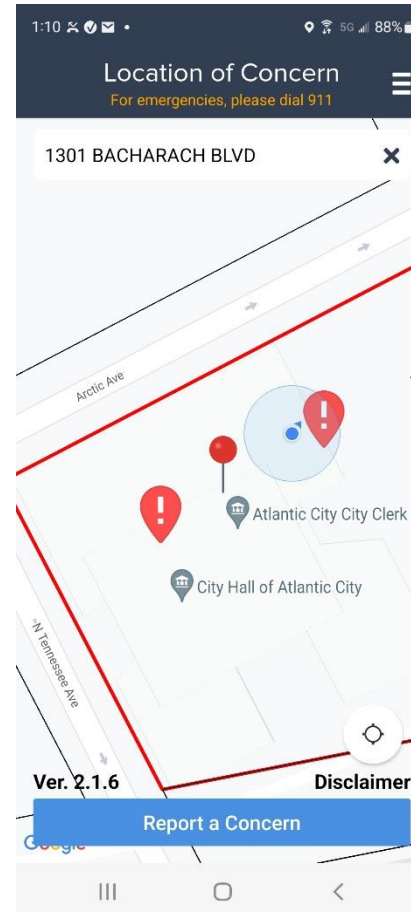

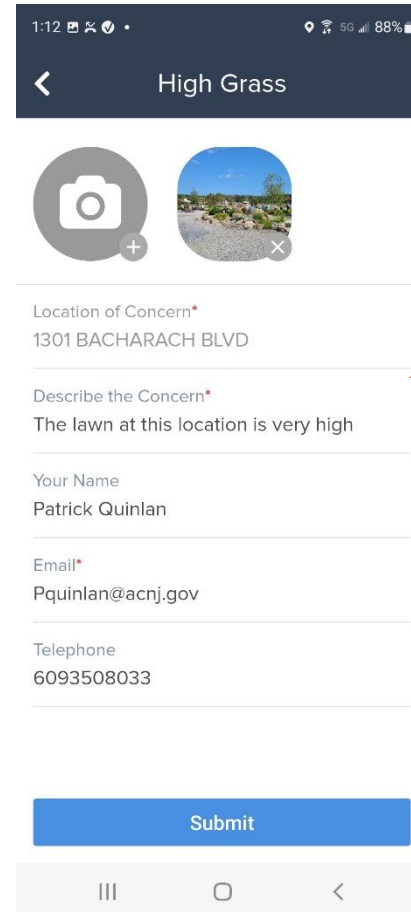
