We have spoken to residents (in the same area) in the past about this issue.

Ninety-three were keep-a-checks that are officer generated and involve roving patrol of a designated area with enforcement of quality-of-life issues and vehicles that are in violation. There were four noise complaints, five calls for vehicles being in violation, and several other different types of calls for service that occurred one or two times. Parking Enforcement has also been deployed to this area to ensure that vehicles are parked in accordance with the traffic laws</p>
