Council Member LACCA Presents the following Ordinance:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ATLANTIC CITY, NEW JERSEY,  
AMENDING CHAPTER 243, ARTICLE 60 OF THE CITY CODE TO ESTABLISH A  
TEN (10) MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT ON WISTERIA ROAD BETWEEN  
PORTER AVENUE AND WEST END AVENUE**

WHEREAS, Chapter 243, article 60 sets forth speed limits for streets in the City of Atlantic City; and

**SECTION 1. AUTHORITY.**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that Chapter 243, Article 60 of the Code of the City of Atlantic City is hereby amended and supplemented by adding the following:

**243-60. Speed limit established; Wisteria Road.**

A. Speed Limit Established. The maximum speed limit on Wisteria Road, from its intersection with Porter Avenue to its intersection with West End Avenue, in both directions of travel, is hereby established as ten (10) miles per hour.

B. Posting Required. The speed limit established by this section shall be effective and enforceable only upon the posting of appropriate signage as required by law and applicable traffic control standards.”

**SECTION 2. SIGNS; IMPLEMENTATION.**

A. The Department of Public Works shall install and maintain official speed limit signs and related traffic control devices required to implement this Ordinance in accordance with the applicable New Jersey requirements.

B. The City Engineer and/or the City’s designated traffic engineering professional is authorized to take such administrative steps as are necessary to support implementation, including documentation of the engineering and traffic investigation where required.

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.**

If any section, subsection, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as required by law; provided, however, that the speed limit established herein shall be enforceable only after the required signage is installed and visible to approaching traffic.
